Itinerary

Day 1: New York International Airport → New York Hotel (33 miles)

Today, pick up in New York international airports (JFK \ EWR \ LGA) and start your trip to the eastern United States. Free Airport pickup time: 08:00-24:00 (The time to meet up with the guide after picking up your luggage)
From there, they will transfer to the hotel. The first day is "free time". However, you can add more activities (with a surcharge) to the day based on your needs after arrival. For First Day Arrival Options details, please refer to the "Consumer Guide" Reference hotel: Crowne Plaza Newark Airport or similar. Meals: Excluded

Airport Pickup:

- 1. Meeting point -Arrival procedure for international flights: wait at the exit
- 2. Meeting point- Arrival procedure for US domestic & Canada flights: Baggage Claim area
- 3. Notes: Free airport pick-up, but you will also need to pay a USD \$15/person/day service fee (payable for adult & child)

First Day Arrival Options:

Day 2: New York City Full Day Tour (Event Time: 11-13 Hour) (60 miles)

Explore iconic landmarks in NYC: Time Square, St. Patrick's Cathedral, Brooklyn Bridge, Wall Street and 9/11 Memorial

Today, we will explore the heart of New York—Manhattan. Our journey begins in Midtown at Times Square, where you'll feel the artistic pulse of Broadway and the financial energy of the NASDAQ Stock Exchange. From there, we'll stroll along Broadway Avenue, passing Central Park, and stop at St. Patrick's Cathedral on Fifth Avenue.

Before heading downtown, we' Il pause by the Hudson River for a visit to the Intrepid Sea, Air & Space Museum, where the mighty USS Intrepid aircraft carrier—now retired—stands as a bold reminder of America's Cold War military strength. After lunch, we' Il continue south along the Hudson River, passing through the Greenwich Village area as we enter Lower Manhattan. Our first stop is Wall Street, where we' Il walk through the "Canyon of Heroes," gaze up at the Gothic spire of Trinity Church, and stand at the crossroads of financial power between the Morgan Building, the New York Stock Exchange, and Federal Hall. Don't forget to snap photos with the famous Fearless Girl and the iconic Charging Bull.

Next, we' Il pass by Battery Park and take a cruise on the East River to catch a close-up view of the Statue of Liberty—one of America' s most beloved symbols and a beacon of hope for generations chasing the American Dream.

After the cruise, we' Il enjoy a scenic walk across the Brooklyn Bridge, where the magnificent views of the East River and the Manhattan skyline come together in a breathtaking panorama. Our final stops include a visit to the 9/11 Memorial, where two reflecting pools stand as the city's silent tears, commemorating a tragedy forever etched into America's memory. Just next door stands the One World Observatory, the tallest building in the United States.

Day 3: New York \rightarrow Philadelphia \rightarrow Washington D.C. (Event Time: 10-12 Hour) (250 miles)

The tour includes visit to White House (Outside Visit), Lincoln Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, Tidal Basin, Air Force Memorial and Pentagon (Passing By).

Today, we will visit Philadelphia, where we will see Independence Hall (Outside Visit) and the Liberty Bell (Outside Visit). Afterward we will continue to Washington, DC to join a Washington DC In-depth Tour. Philadelphia, one of the most historically significant cities in the United States, Philadelphia was the first capital of the U.S. The City of Brotherly Love draws history buffs and lovers of culture from all corners of the globe! Washington, DC, the capital of the United States of America sits on the scenic Potomac River. Monuments, museums, and Americana characterize this historic city, which is in the District of Columbia between the states of Maryland and Virginia.

Day 4: Washington DC→Watkins Glen (Summer)/Corning Glass Center (Winter)→Niagara Fall (Time:11-13H) (469 miles) Watkins Glen + Seneca Lake + Niagara Falls Illumination Package Include admission to Watkins Glen (replace by Corning Glass Center if close), Seneca Lake (Passing By)., Niagara Falls Illumination and summer limited fireworks.

Today we will go to visit the Watkins Glen (if closed in winter, we'll visit Corning Glass Center instead). As we reach Niagara Falls , fulfilling the long-awaited visit to the Cave of the Winds wooden walkway (closed after October 20th). With nightfall, join us for a nighttime excursion to Goat Island, where amidst the misty colorful lights, lies a fairy-tale waterfall exclusive to the night. Finally, follow the evening breeze to ascend Luna Island. Niagara Falls, NY, Among the most beautiful natural wonders in the world, Niagara Falls are comprised of three waterfalls that thunder and astound, producing a higher flow rate than any other waterfall in the world and standing at a height of 167 feet.

Day 5: Niagara Fall→ Boston (Event Time: 11-13Hour) (350 miles)

Whirlpool State Park + Lake Erie + Niagara Falls Observation Deck + Buffalo City Tour Package. Include visits to Whirlpool State Park, Lake Erie, Niagara Falls Observation Deck and Buffalo city tour.

In the morning, head to admire the Whirlpool Park landscape, overlooking the whirlpool and canyon to feel the awe-inspiring power of nature. Following downstream along the Niagara Gorge, the not-to-be-missed experience is the Niagara Hot Air



Balloon Adventure at dawn. Next is a close encounter with the falls, the eagerly anticipated Maid of the Mist boat tour. After, we will arrive at Buffalo. This city bears both glory and desolation, being the start of the Erie Canal and the source of waterfall

waters. Let us climb to the observation tower to experience the grandeur of the Great Lakes and listen carefully to the rise and fall of this city. Last, we will drive to Boston.

And be able to take a Boston Harbor cruise to see views of the city. After that, we will go to New York. Boston is a city as beautiful as it is historically significant. Visitors can walk the Freedom Trail and see where the seeds of the American Revolution were sown or visit the North End and look out over the harbor.
